Rule 1

If the singular name of the noun ends with *s, ss, sh, ch, x, or z*, then an 'es' has to be put at the end of the noun to make it plural. Let us see some nouns that fall under this

#### Rule 4

If the noun ends with 'y' and is preceded by a consonant, then 'ies' is added to the noun in plural form. If the noun ends with 'y' and is preceded by a vowel, then 's' is added to the noun in plural form. Let's see the nouns ending with 'y' and a consonant before it.
